Wrexham & Shropshire has announced that it is to commence operations between Marylebone and Wrexham from 28 April 2008 with a service of five trains on weekdays, four on Saturdays and three on Sundays. Services will call at Ruabon, Chirk, Gobowen, Shrewsbury, Wellington, Telford Central, Cosford, Wolverhampton ((set down only southbound/pick up only northbound), Tame Bridge Parkway and Banbury (set down only southbound/pick up only northbound). The company has also announced that it will be hiring in trains for the start of service as its own stock is still undergoing refurbishment.
